

# Maryland HIV Planning

- HIV Planning Group (HPG)
  - Statewide mandate
  - Required by CDC
  - Focuses on prevention, but recognizes treatment as prevention
  - Newly created in 2013 to replace CPG, and still developing processes
- Regional Advisory Committees (RACs)
  - 5 regions (Central, Eastern, Southern, Suburban, Western)
  - Satisfies HRSA requirement
  - Focuses on prevention and services
- Exploring formal relationship between HPG and RACs

# Maryland HIV Plan

- 2012-2014 Maryland HIV Plan (September 2012)
  - Available on DHMH website:

- One unified document that was developed to respond to multiple planning requirements of CDC, HRSA, and NHAS
  - Comprehensive HIV Plan
  - Statewide Coordinated Statement of Need
  - Maryland HIV Prevention Plan
- Includes data from the Maryland HIV/AIDS Epidemiological Profile
- Produced by DHMH (with Univ. of MD) and reviewed by CPG/HPG

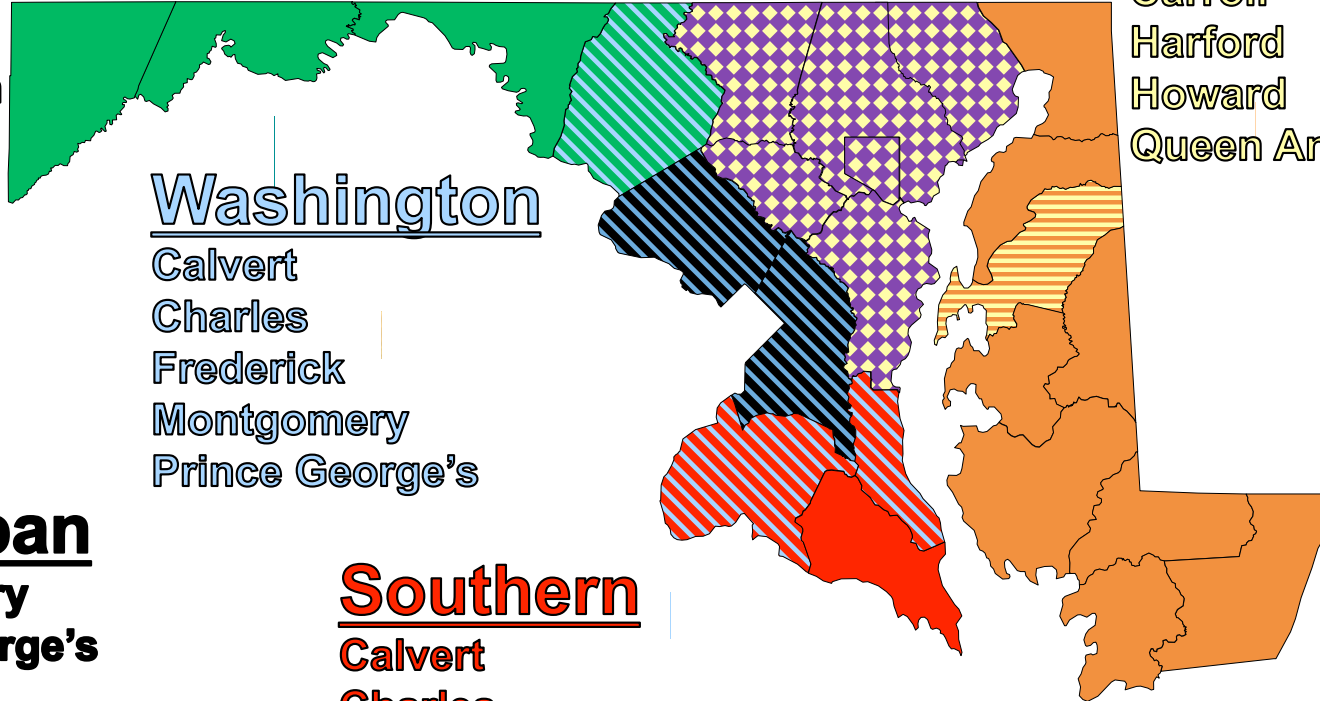
## Other HIV Planning Bodies in Maryland

  - Baltimore-Towson MSA (Baltimore City and six Maryland counties)
  - Required by HRSA
  - Focuses on services
- Metropolitan Washington Regional Ryan White Planning Council
  - Washington MSA (includes 5 Maryland counties)
  - Required by HRSA
  - Focuses on services
- Baltimore City HIV Planning Group (HPG)
  - Baltimore City
  - Required by CDC
  - Focuses on prevention

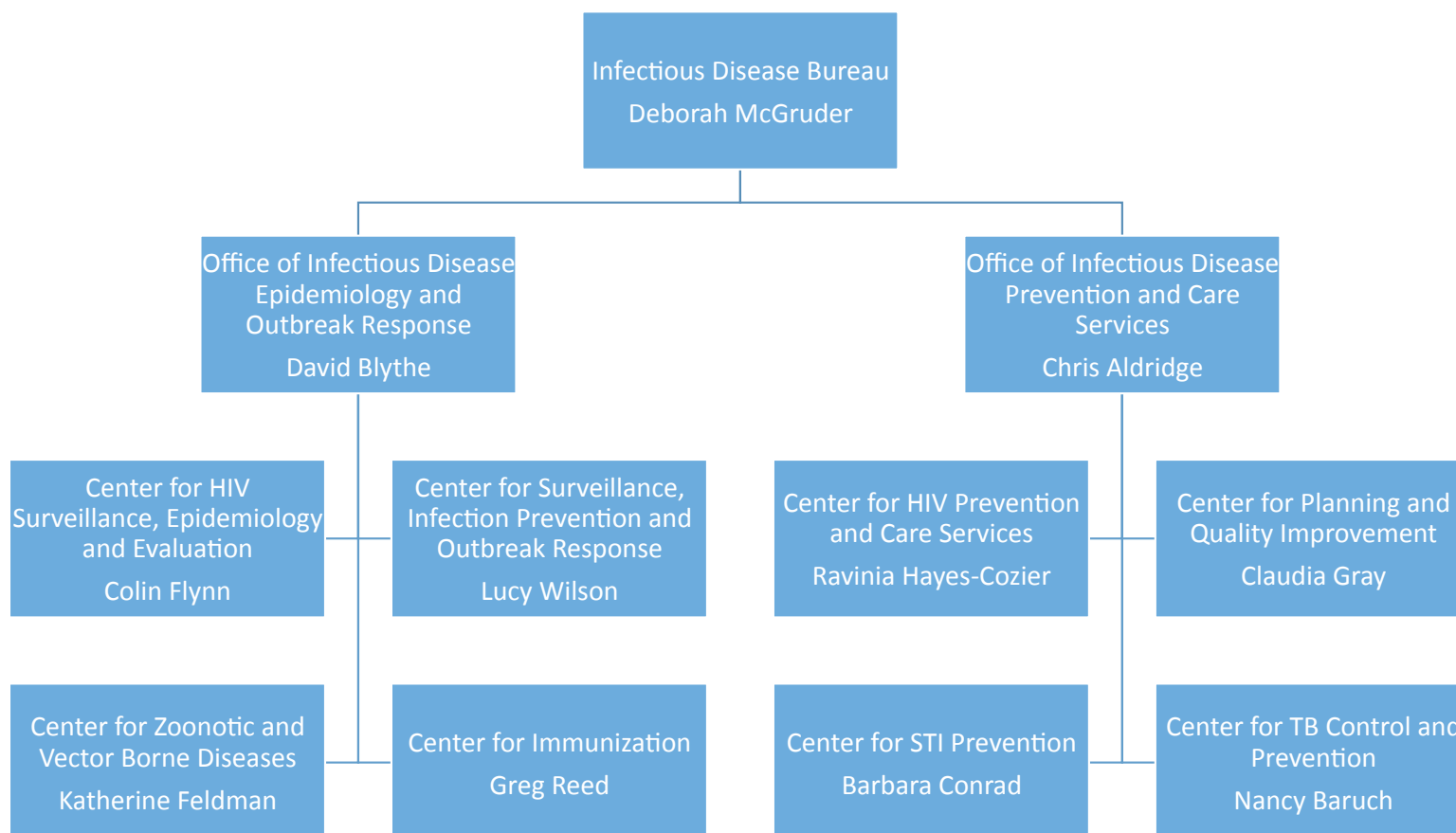
